# Primary Voting Starts Friday, 6/28

## What is a PRIMARY Election?

A primary election determines which candidate for each party will be on the ballot in November. For example, candidate A from political party X for a US House Seat wants to be on the ballot in November. Candidate A must win the August primary election against others from party X in order to represent party X on the November election ballot.

NOTE: You can only vote for candidates from one political party. If you vote for candidates from more than one political party, your ballot will NOT be counted.

## Why Should I Vote?

Hundreds of Delegates, some being those you elected caucus night from your precinct, try to be informed on candidates and vote to 'endorse' the candidate they believe will be the best candidate to oppose other party candidate(s) in November. Primary races happen when the losing candidate of a party files to run against the Endorsed candidate of their party.

Voting gets your voice heard. Be informed by reviewing campaign websites and find opportunities to MEET the candidates. Look for debates. Once informed, be sure to contact your fellow voters to share your thoughts on candidates and encourage them to vote!

Two high level seats in our area will be on YOUR primary ballot:

**US Senate** seat to go against Democrat Senator Amy Klobuchar
